Function, Roles & Responsibility:

The GB is responsible for the management of the Institution. Its function shall include the following:

- c) To scrutinize and accept the audited statement of account for each year.
- d) To estimate the work load, approve the staff pattern and create posts-teaching and non-teaching (Technical and administrative) for the Institution.
- e) To consider and approve the proposals for creation of infrastructure such as building, equipment, Library and staff on a continuous basis.
- f) To Consider and make provisions for meeting the general and specific conditions laid down by AICTE, The State Government RGPV, Bhopal and monitoring the progress in fulfilling the conditions:
- g) To consider the report of the Principal on status of admissions:
- h) To consider the report of the Principal on the academic performance of the students.
- i) To supervise the observance of service Conditions of the staff as prescribed.
- j) To Consider the proposals of the Principal for improvement in academic performance of the staff.
- k) To consider any other matter which enhance the academic atmosphere in the institution.
- l) To consider any proposal for expansion of educational activities to be made to the AICTE/Government/RGPV Bhopal.

The Meeting of Governing Body will be held 2 times in a year. The meeting of the Committees should be held as often as required. The Principal of the institutions, who is the members Secretary, shall be responsible for organizing the meeting as required. The notice of the meeting should be sent to all the members so as to reach them at least 15 days in advance. The agenda papers with details should reach the members at least a week in advance. Principals shall be responsible for preparing the minutes of the meeting.



Member secretary had read out the minutes of GB meeting No. 1 of 08/11/2021. The minutes and action taken report of the said GB were noted and confirmed.

Item No: 2. Conduct of University Examinations

<u>University Examination Dec 2021:</u> The semester examination for the odd semester of Jul-Dec 2021 ended in Mar 2022. They were conducted online. The examinations for various semester started from 10/12/2021 for 7th semester, 13/12/2021 for 5th sem followed by 3rd semester in mid Jan 2022 and 1st sem last week of Feb & early Mar 2022. The examinations were conducted online by University and proper arrangements were made to students in College also for all the examinations. The point was noted and taken.

<u>University Examination Jun 2022:</u>The semester examination for the even semester of Jan-Jun 2022 will be starting from 12/05/2022 till 23/05/2022 for 7th semester students. They are conducted offline. The examinations for 5th will start from 14/05/2022 till 30/05/2022. The examination for 4th sem will start from end of May to mid Jun 2022. The examinations for 2nd semester will go in Jul2022. The examinations will be conducted offline by University and

proper arrangements for conducting offline papers and practicals are well planned and faculties and staff are prepared accordingly. The point was noted and taken.

Item No: 03. Result of December 2021 Examinations: The results of December 2021 had been received in Feb-Mar 2022 and compiled and were placed for kind perusal of the committee. There are all subjects in different courses, with encouraging 100% results. Students had certainly utilized their facilities to answer well online.

The Committee members had perused through the results and suggested to go all out, work hard and motivate students and faculties to improve. Member secretary had assured for the same.

Item No: 4. General information regarding academic activities in the College:

<u>Commencement of 08th Semester B.Tech:</u> The semester had started from 24/01/2022. 100% course coverage has been ensured by 14/05/2022. The course conduction was well planned with remedial classes for weak and absentee students. The point was appreciated and noted.

Commencement of 06th Semester B.Tech. The semester had started from 01/02/2022. 100% course coverage was to be ensured by 27/05/2022. The course conduction had been well planned with remedial classes for weak and absentee students. The course had been in final phase now. The point was appreciated and noted.

Commencement of 04th Semester B.Tech. & M.Tech. The semester had started from 21/02/2022. 100% course coverage will be ensured by 10/06/2022. The course conduction have been well planned with remedial classes for weak and absentee students. The course has been going on well right now. The point was appreciated and noted.

Commencement of 2nd Semester B.Tech. and 2nd Semester of M. Tech. The semester had started from 16/03/2022. 100% course coverage will be ensured by 06/07/2022. The course conduction have been well planned with remedial classes for weak and absentee students. The course has been going on well right now. The point was appreciated and noted. Admission in 1st Year. We have yet to receive guidelines for admissions in 1st year courses of B.Tech & M. Tech from DTE, Govt. of M.P. through Online counselling for B.Tech courses for session on 2023-24 The time table for the same is awaited. College shall plan and prepare for reporting of students accordingly.

<u>Seminar, Expert Lectures & Industrial Visits.</u> There are large number of these activities were conducted between Dec 2021 to May 2022. These activities were readout from Academic activity calendar published by us every month. Once activities were concluded. These

activities were published and put on various social media platforms. The members had lauded for the efforts and expressed their appreciation. The point was noted.

Recruitment of teaching and Non-teaching Staff: Based on the recruitment projected by the heads of Departments, the recruitment is ongoing process which is continued.

<u>Participation in Hackathone Events:</u> Our mentors had motivated to work on different problems on various themes. Our students are working hard to participate in near future in Smart India Hackathon 2022 which will be organized somewhere in Jul-Aug 2022. We are sure of getting shortlisted in 3-4 teams.

<u>Project Atal Tunnel Yojna</u>: Our Students from Civil Engineer had visited Atal Tunnel at Manali. They learnt a lot on this unique visit. The project was organized by AICTE.

Library Information: Member secretary apprised that wi-fi facilities were smoothly working in Library premises and students were happily using these facilities. The timing of the library had been from 09 am to 08 pm. The students from the hostels and also those Students adjacent as per their requirement and convenience in evening time. Students are time and again educated not to tear pages from the books. They are also advised to return books by due dates, so that these books are available to other students also whenever they are needing them. We requested all faculties to communicate the above points in classes of their respective departments. It was stated by member secretary that they had worked out requirement of books and placed orders, considering introduction of new subjects branches. up gradation of Syllabus, addition of new books, reading materials etc. As seats in CSE (IOT) & CSE (AIML) courses were further increased to 120 in Academic year 2021. So, you will see about 120 students in 3rd Semester and 60 students in 5th Semester now. Please do equip our library with sufficient books of these courses accordingly. It is also noted that intakes are increased to 180 in B.Tech AIDS, CSE (IOT) & CSE (AIML). So we need to prepare accordingly for 1st year and also for senior classes. The List of books procured in last year are produced herewith. All are requested to kindly peruse through it. Departments had confirmed the satisfactory level of books available in the library. Further they had adequate reference books available in their departmental libraries which are made use of by their faculties. All faculties were time and again requested to motivate students to read English news papers daily. Those interested in research shall be motivated to use research journals. Students shall be repeatedly made educated to handle books carefully and return in time. All the Members had jointly expressed that they all need to ask their faculty to promote more us of Library facilities by themselves and motivate their students also.
