Expert Talk & Alumni Interaction

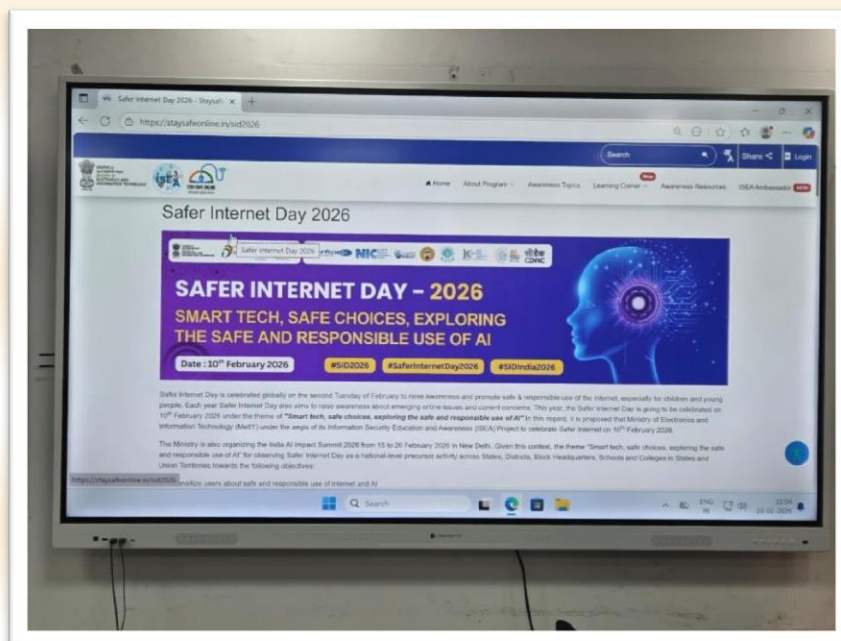
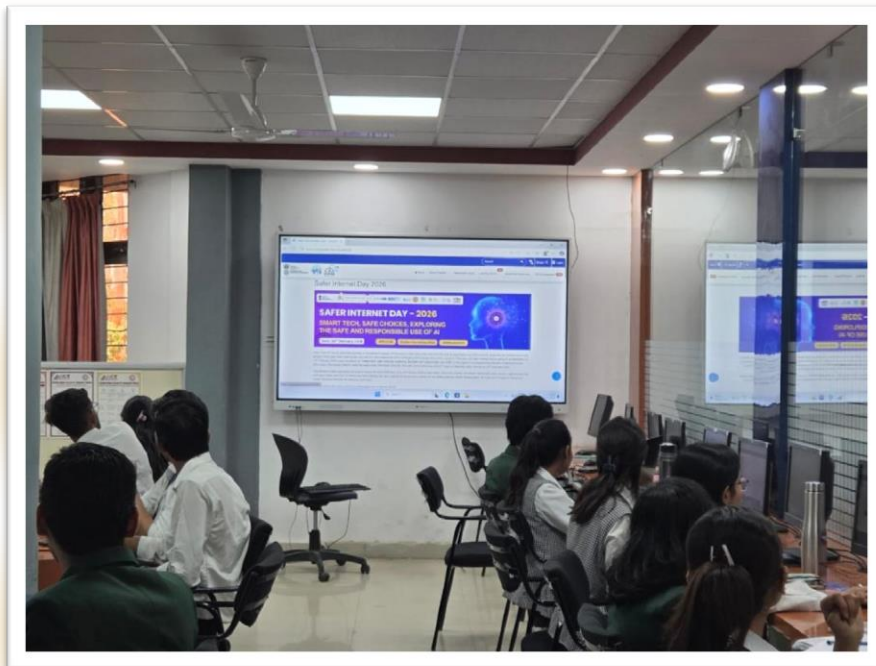


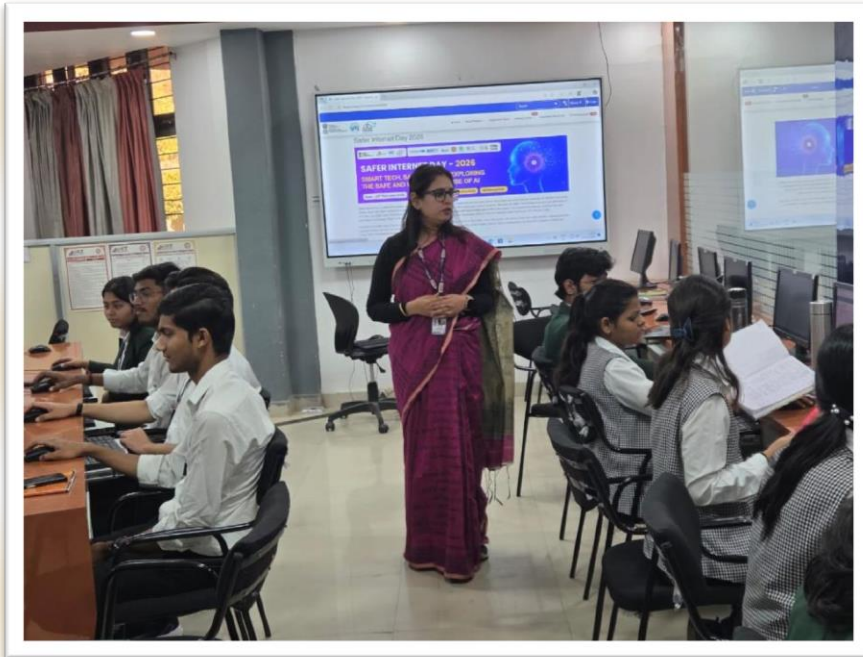

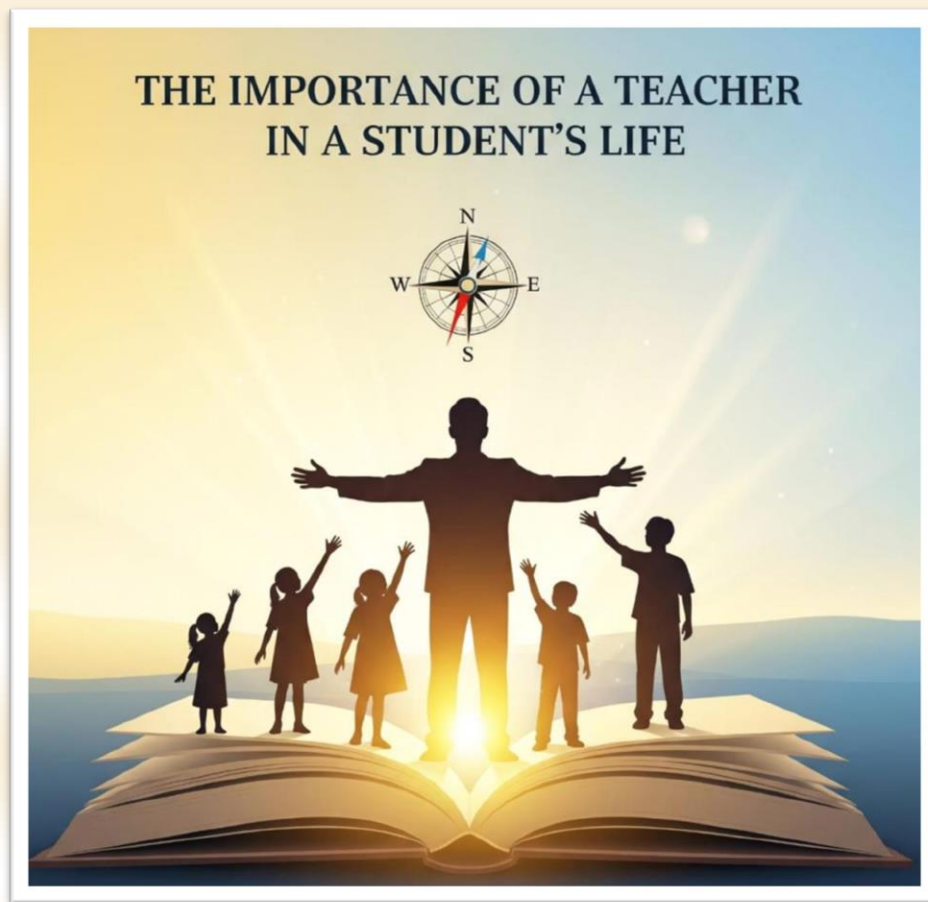


Digital Poster Making Competition

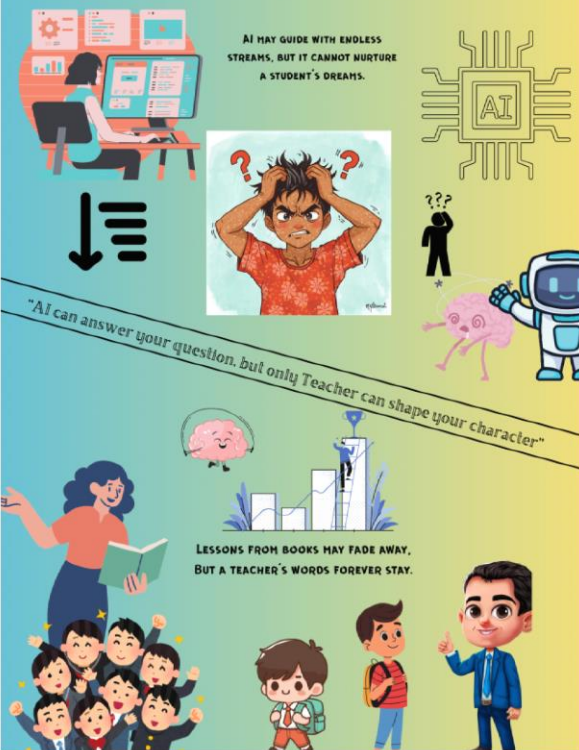

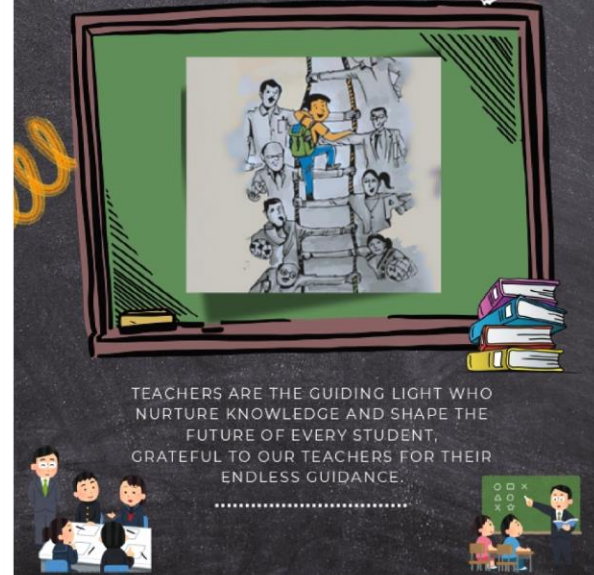

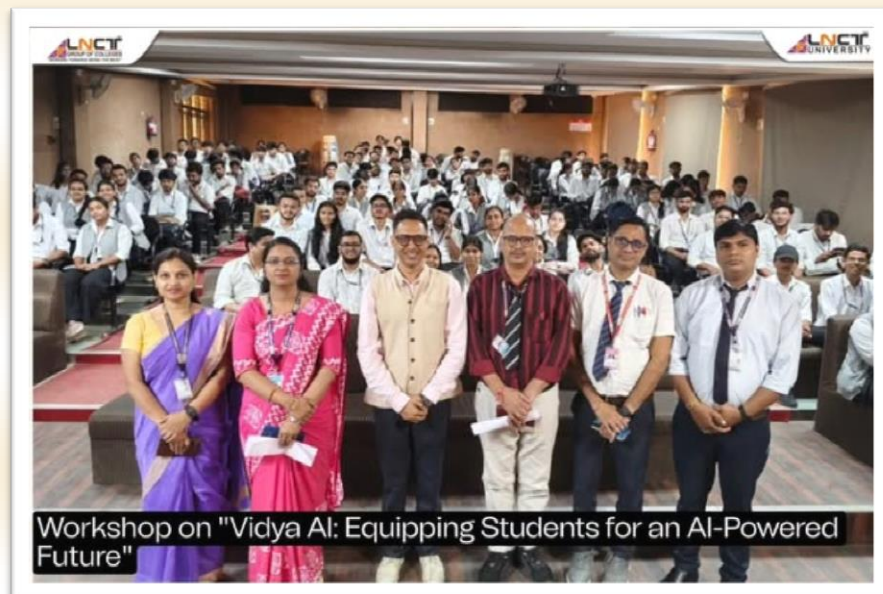


Workshop on “Vidya AI”
